Adobe Captivate: A New Spring Report Widget

This very simple widget allows you to report a variable back to the LMS of [A New Spring](#). With this widget you can report answers even if the Captivate project does not have any quiz slides or interactive elements. This allows you to use Captivate projects for Multimedia questions in the A New Spring platform.

- This widget is provided as is, without warranty of any kind.
- This widget is in ActionScript 3 widget and is tested with Captivate 5 and 5.5.

Usage

Using this widget is a two step process:

1. Add the widget to the slide you want to report a value.
2. In the widget properties, add the name of the variable you want to report to A New Spring.
